

Job Announcement – Urban Forestry Program Director

Are you passionate about trees and community engagement? Join Greenscape of Jacksonville, Inc. in our mission to expand Northeast Florida's tree canopy and grow our community of tree advocates.

The Urban Forestry Program Director will direct and oversee Greenscape's programs, from volunteer-based tree plantings to communicating with public officials to offering programs for schools and more. Working closely with staff, the director will oversee the daily operations of projects, develop new projects, write and manage grants, collaborate across the organization, and ensure projects are on schedule and on budget. They will seek new opportunities and partnerships through ongoing collaboration with the city, community groups, residents, and other nonprofits.

Job Type: Full Time, In-Person

Salary: \$55,000 - \$75,000, plus health benefit stipend; vacation, sick and holiday PTO.

Location: Jacksonville, FL

Essential Functions:

- Oversee the daily operations of all programs: volunteer tree plantings, tree maintenance, community outreach & education, and communication with public officials & stakeholders
- Manage, communicate with, and track volunteers using Bloomerang
- Develop tools and metrics to measure and assess projects
- In collaboration with partners and liaisons, identify opportunities for new projects and programs
- Write, manage, and report on grants
- Work with public officials and facilitate public meetings
- Work with staff to see that projects are on time, on budget, and meet the grant requirements

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in science field or education. Additional industry specific training is desirable.
- Minimum of 3 years of experience managing programs around issues of urban forestry and/or ecology, environmental education and environmental justice
- Experience in the fields of environmental science, arboriculture and/or nonprofit management
- Understand and able to communicate the ecosystem benefits of trees to multiple audiences
- Understand and communicate trees as tool for environmental justice, resilience, and green infrastructure
- Live in Northeast Florida
- Driver's license and good driving record
- Availability to work some Saturdays and evening events
- Able to lift at least 25 lbs
- Pass a background check
